Over the last quarter we made voting recommendations at **299** meetings (**4,151** resolutions). At **168** of those meetings we recommended opposing one or more resolutions. We recommended voting with management by exception at **four** meetings and we supported management on all resolutions at the remaining **127** meetings.






